become either a power for good or evil, according to the direction which you yourself give it. Lord, Almighty Power! Strengthen mine infirm soul in every virtue! Stablish my heart, weak for everything good, upon the immovable rock of Thy commandments! Lord, I daily recognize, through experience, that without Thee I myself am nothing, that without Thee I can do no good; without Thee evil in its various forms is alone within"
